Barbara Bowling Coleman departed this life on Monday, September 14, 2020, at the age of 77 years and 12 days. She was born in Hardin County, Tennessee on September 2, 1943, the daughter of the late Fred Burton Bowling and Gladys Lucille Thurman Bowling. On May 14, 1967, she was united in marriage to Bayward Gene Coleman, who survives,

Barbara was a lifelong Hardin Countian and was employed with Tennessee Valley Electric Cooperative. After 46 years of service to the company, she retired in 2018. 
